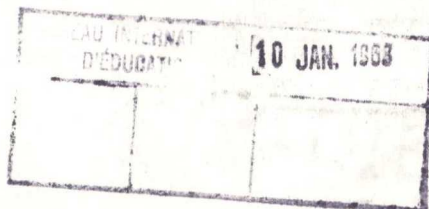

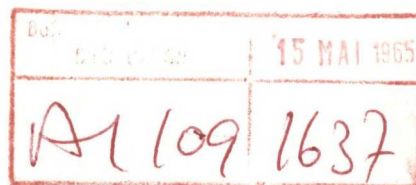

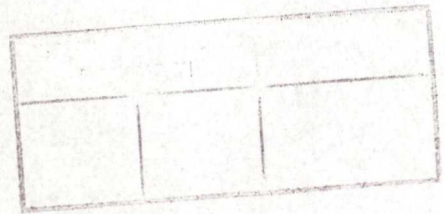

We have just received a copy of the letter* (ref. No. 34311/17/81/CAA) of 24th February, addressed to the Crown Agents for Overseas in London, requesting them to pay us the sum of Sw. frs. 10,000 for the year 1964.

Further to the conversation which you had with a member of our secretariat, on 13th July, 1961, concerning the possibility of your country becoming a member of the International Bureau of Education, we are enclosing herewith the information you requested.

All countries which are Members of the International Bureau of Education take an active part in the drawing up of decisions affecting the Bureau's general policy, the research it undertakes and the programme of the annual International Conference on Public Education. For this purpose, the member countries are invited to be represented each year at the Council Meeting (which takes place within the dates set for the International Conference on Public Education) and at the meeting of the Executive Committee held in the spring of each year.

Such member countries have the right to a stand in the permanent International Exhibition of Public Education and can have recourse in a direct and particularly useful way to the various documentary services of the Bureau.

The annual contribution of member countries to the International Bureau of Education is 5,000 or 10,000 Swiss francs, depending on the size of the stand referred to above and reserved for them.

We are enclosing herewith various documents relative to the activities of the International Bureau of Education. Should you wish for further information on any particular point, we shall be pleased to supply it.
